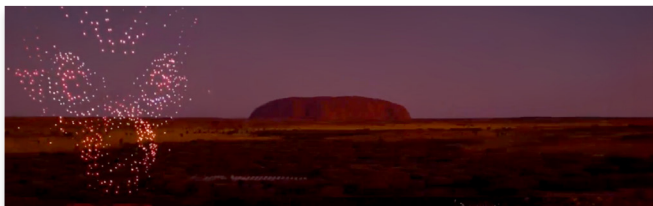

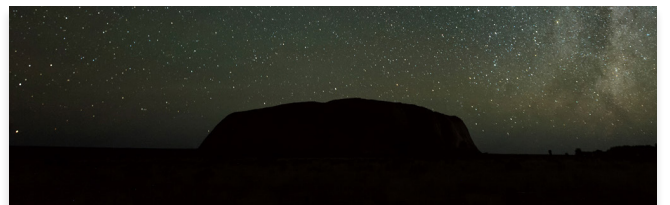
## Bush Food Experience
